* Definition of Audio-Visual Aids :-

- "Audio visual aids are any device which can be used -to make the teaching experience more realistic and more dynamic."
- "Audio visual aids are those sensory objects or images which initiate or stimulate and reinforce learning".
- Audio visual aids are anything by means of which learning process may be encouraged or carried on through the sense of hearing or sense of sight."

Audio aids are learning materials that engage the auditory sense, meaning they can only be heard. They are used to reinforce lessons through speech, such as through radio broadcasts, tape recordings, or music and can make learning more dynamic and engaging. Ex- radios, cassette players, and language labs. Hearing aids are sound-amplifying devices designed to help people who have hearing loss. Most hearing aids share several similar electronic components. A microphone that picks up sound. Amplifier circuitry that makes the sound louder.
